



ITEMS NOT ACCEPTABLE FOR COLLECTION INCLUDE:

- Automobile parts including motors, tires on rims, doors, fenders, car seats, batteries, bumpers
- Bricks
- Brush
- Building/Construction Materials
- Central air conditioning or heating units
- Ceramic tile
- Chain link fencing
- Cinderblocks
- Concrete
- Dirt
- Duct or sheet metal materials
- Electronic waste ▪ PLEASE NOTE: televisions and computers and related computer equipment are banned from landfills. This includes CPUs, laptops, monitors, printers, printer/fax/scan devices, mice and keyboards; and all televisions, including flat-panel televisions, projection televisions and televisions with picture tubes.
- Fence posts with concrete attached
- Fire-damaged items
- Grocery carts
- Floor coverings (except carpet/padding installed or removed by homeowner)
- Marble or simulated marble countertops
- Oil Drums
- Paint & other hazardous waste
- Plaster
- Propane/oxygen tanks
- Railroad ties
- Rocks
- Roofing materials, shingles
- Sand
- Sheetrock
- Shingles
- Soil
- Antifreeze / Used Oil
- Fluorescent Bulbs
- Tires - Recreational and/or farm equipment tires will not be collected.
- Yard waste

▪ Non-hazardous materials accepted during this event are: Acceptable Waste, bulk items such as furniture, mattresses and other items too large to fit in the Cart. **It does not include:** Excluded Waste, white goods, appliances, electronics, hazardous materials, auto parts, batteries or yard waste. Unacceptable - White Goods – (not linens) are major appliances. Washer, dryer, fridge, AC unit, freezer, dishwasher, water heater, etc. They gained this name due to the default “white color” they are typically known for.

▪ Excluded Waste: any regulated quantity of a Hazardous Waste or Hazardous Substance as defined by federal, state, or local laws or regulations; unidentified containerized wastes, sludge(s), waste from a pollution control process or cleanup of a chemical spill or chemical substance, waste tires, biohazards or regulated medical waste, friable asbestos, construction or demolition waste, soil, sod, tree branches and stumps, paint, motor oil, and excessive storm debris or debris resulting from weather events.
